Rhydd Barn is an 1850s stone barn built out of Malvern granite sympathetically restored to a light, open and airy style across three levels. There is gas central heating throughout, tiled and wooden floors and white walls interspersed with pine beams and black iron work.

Rhydd Barn is ideally suited to accommodate two persons.

Ground floor kitchen and dining (and sitting) area

Features

- Light, open plan ground floor room with under-floor heating and attractive kitchen area with gas hob/electric oven, microwave, dishwasher, fridge, and access to a freezer.
- Wifi 
- Dining and sitting areas with views to the Malvern Hills.
- Ground floor high pressure shower with separate toilet and washbasin.
- Ground floor utility room with washing machine and gas boiler—a convenient area for drying wet clothes.
- Open pine staircase to first floor.
- First floor sitting room with west-facing French windows to balcony/outside steps with outstanding views of the Malvern Hills.
- 'Smart' HD television (with all 'catch-up' channels/YouTube etc), DVD player, record player/audio cassette/radio mini-system, portable DAB (digital)/FM radio with CD player, USB charging points.

- Stable door entrance into first floor double bedroom with fitted pine wardrobe and high quality ensuite main bathroom.
- Open pine steps to galleried 2nd floor study with attractive views to south. A futon sofa bed allows this to be used as an extra sleeping area.
- Attractive south and west facing patio with adjacent lawn and views over fields to the Malvern Hills.
- Outdoor table and chairs available.
- Parking space for up to two cars to the north side.
- Superb views of the Malvern Hills both inside and outside

Location

Rhydd Barn is situated close to the **Malvern Hills**—a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty—with common land to the east and 14 acres of meadow to the west. It is easily accessible by road.

The attractive village of **Hanley Swan** is 2 miles away with outstanding pub/restaurant The Swan. **Barnard's Green**, a convenient and pleasant local shopping centre is only 3 miles down the road, with banks, a post office, butcher, greengrocer, fishmonger, baker, small Co-op supermarket and many specialist shops and take-away food outlets.

The **Three Counties' Showground** is 4 miles away. It hosts the Spring Garden Show, Agricultural Show, Antique Show and many others.

A little further on is **Malvern**, its charm and character owing much to the beauty of the Hills rising behind and the Georgian and Victorian houses built as a result of the pure 'spa water' found there. Highlights include the attractive Malvern Priory, the Festival Theatre and, of

course, the Malvern Hills themselves from which the views are breath-taking—on a clear day you can see 50 miles in any direction.

To the south east of the Barn is **Upton-upon-Severn**, a vibrant small town focused on the River Severn with Tudor and Georgian houses and shops. It is host to many festivals including a Folk Festival in May and a Water Festival on August Bank Holiday. There is a wonderful walk along the banks of the Severn to beautiful water meadows.

The county town of **Worcester** is 10 miles to the north with its attractively situated cathedral overlooking the River Severn and the famous Royal Worcester porcelain works (now a museum). It is one of the venues for the Three Choirs Festival.

Rhydd Barn makes an ideal centre from which to pursue cultural and walking interests in the Malvern area and enjoy the beautiful countryside which inspired many of Edward Elgar's compositions.

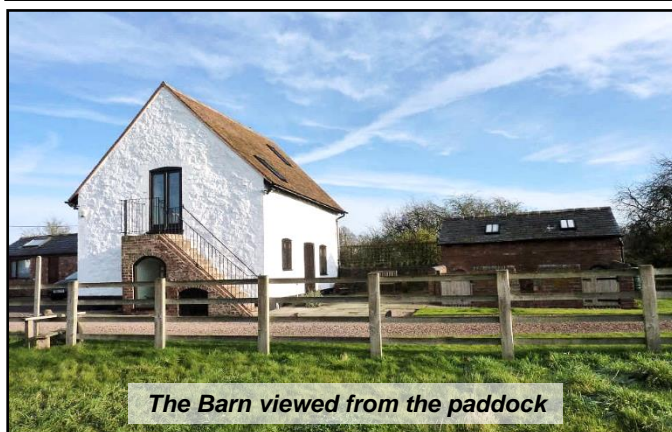

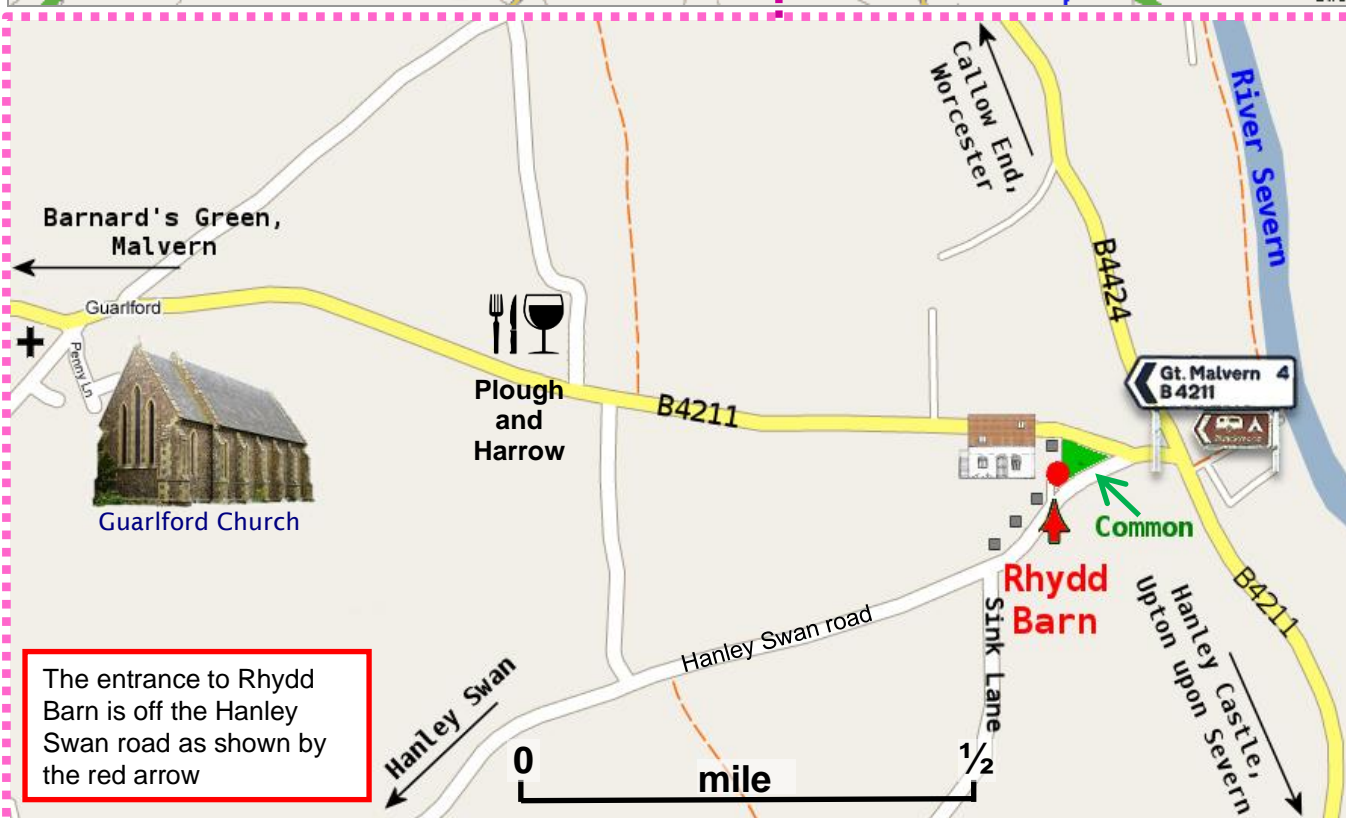
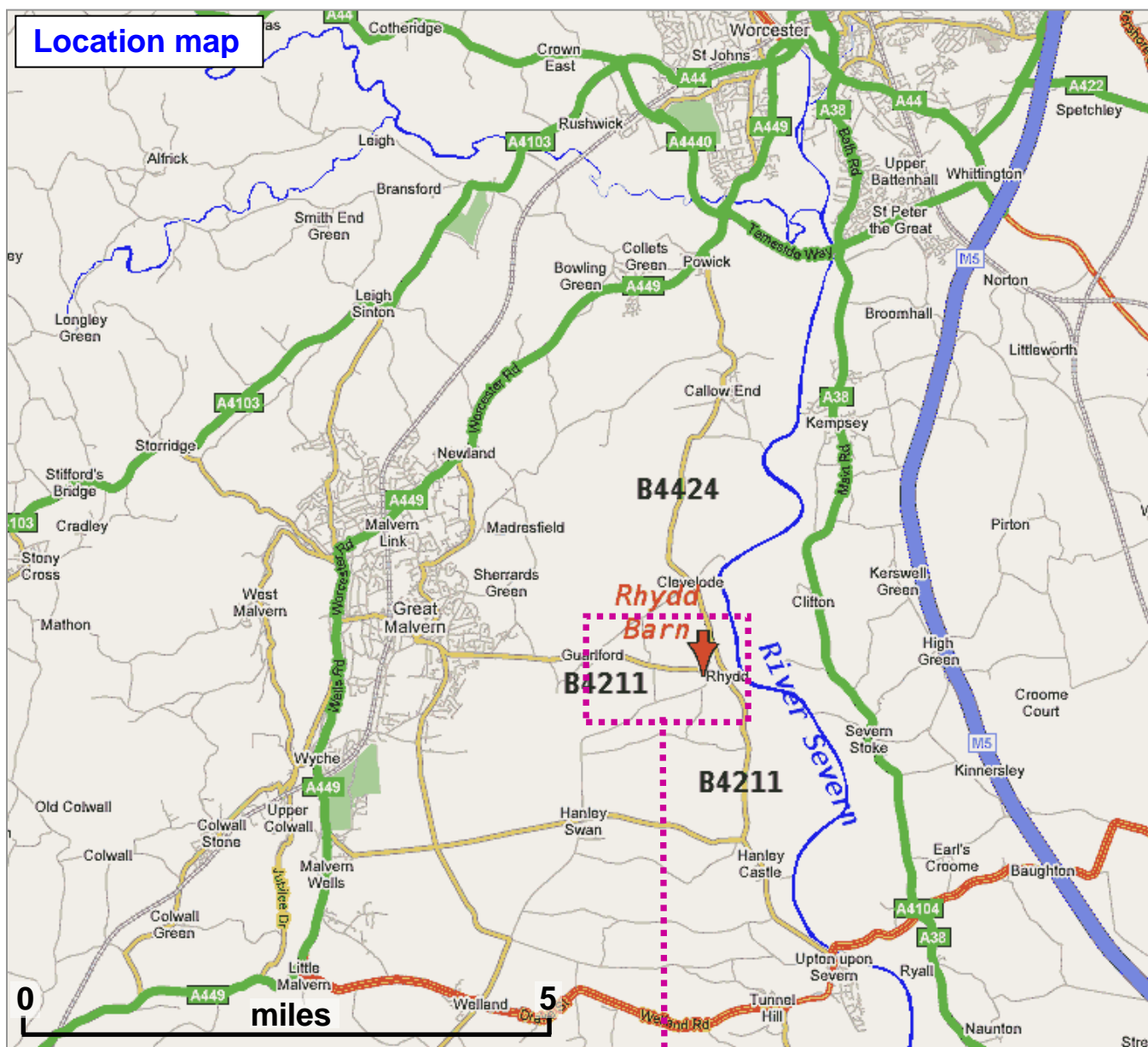
